



Avionics Technician

The Avionics Technician will repair, modify, install, troubleshoot, and perform routine maintenance of all Avionics systems with accuracy and with minimal assistance. Will need to accurately interpret maintenance manuals, service bulletins, wiring diagrams, system schematics, drawings, engineering orders and other documents.

Job Duties:

- Perform routine maintenance, avionics installations and set up.
- Troubleshoot and repair and/or check complex systems.
- Properly use Avionics hand tools to perform repairs and installations.
- Take immediate corrective action regarding unsafe conditions.
- Operate ground support equipment as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

Job Requirements:

- 2 years minimum field experience or avionics related technical schooling
- Previous employment in either a certified or high performance experimental aircraft desirable
- Proficient with using hand tools
- Excellent computer skills
- Ability to follow CADD drawings & electrical schematics
- Basic knowledge of avionics tooling
- High level attention to detail.
- Experience with Garmin G1000 and/or G900X preferable
- Proven ability to troubleshoot basic problems.
- Knowledge of other aircraft systems e.g. hydraulic, flight controls, etc. and major components.
- High energy level with ability to multi-task while balancing and prioritizing project work with daily responsibilities.
